

Obtaining Autopart V20 Database Connection Details

The database connection details are stored in a file named autopart.ini as follows:

```
[CONNECTIONS]
Connections=1
ServerName1=DATASERVER
Username1=XXX_WS1
Password1=
Database1=Autopart
```

If Autopart is running on a terminal server, the ini file should be found in the following path on the terminal server:

C:\Autopart\Accounts

In this folder you will find a folder for each workstation, e.g.

C:\Autopart\Accounts\WS_01*

*Make sure the folder name matches the name of the workstation being used in Autopart as there can be variants which are configured for non-live databases.

The ini files for each workstation are contained in these folders. Note that Autopart uses a different SQL user for each workstation. You should select the login details for the workstation on which the Sales-i utility is going to be installed.

If Autopart is installed directly on a client PC you should search for a file named autopart.ini – it should be in a location similar to the terminal server.

The Sales-i utility should be configured with the following information from the ini file.

|------------|-------------------------------|
| Server: | Use ServerName1 from ini file |
| Database: | Use Database1 from ini file |
| User Name: | Use UserName1 from ini file |
| Password: | Use Password1 from ini file |
